

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT

FRANKLIN, SS.

To either Constable of the Town of Rowe in the County of Franklin,

GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Rowe, qualified to vote in the elections and town affairs, to meet at the **ROWE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** in said **ROWE** on **TUESDAY**, the **TWENTIETH** day of **SEPTEMBER 2011**, at **7:00 P.M.** in the evening, then and there to act on the following:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to **TRANSFER** the sum of **\$10,527.00** from the Transfer Station **RECYCLING SHED** account to a Transfer Station **TREE REMOVAL** account to pay an **EXPENSE** incurred in a prior year and without an appropriation, or take any action in relation thereto.

NOTE: 9/10ths vote is required to pass Article 1

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to pay a **PRIOR YEAR BILL** in the amount of **\$38.80** for Verizon from the Police Department Operations account, or take any action in relation thereto.

NOTE: 9/10ths vote is required to pass Article 2

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to **TRANSFER** the sum of **\$3,000.00** from the **STABILIZATION FUND** to the **Unemployment Insurance** account, or take any action in relation thereto.

NOTE: 2/3 vote is required to pass Article 3

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will vote to **TRANSFER** the sum of **\$1,200.00** from the **STABILIZATION FUND** to the **Building Inspections** account, or take any action in relation thereto.

NOTE: 2/3 vote is required to pass Article 4

ARTICLE 5: To see if the town will vote to amend the Town By-laws by adding a by-law linking **payment of Selectmen's stipends to attendance at Board of Selectmen's meetings**, or take any action in relation thereto.

[Specific wording will be submitted at town meeting.]

[Note: There is no intention to see additional funds for the stipend line item.]

ARTICLE 6: To see if the town will vote to act on the following **Citizens' Petition**:

Petition to change By-laws Article III, section 5 to read:


The Board of Health shall consist of five (5) members, each to be elected to a three-year term. Two members of said Board shall be elected on each of two consecutive years and one on the third year by ballot at each annual town election. The Board shall have powers and duties as set forth in Chapter 111 of the general laws and other applicable laws. The Board of Health shall appoint the Public Health Nurse, the Health Agent and the Transfer Station Attendant, The Board of Health shall maintain the Refuse Garden and the Transfer Station,"

ARTICLE 6: To transact any other business that may lawfully come before the meeting.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the **Rowe Town Hall** and the **Rowe Transfer Station** in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of the Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time of said meeting, as aforesaid.




